Symbol	Description	
	Clear tough plastic such as soft drink, juice and water bottles.	
	Common white or coloured plastic such as milk containers and shampoo bottles.	
	Hard rigid clear plastic such as cordial bottles.	
	Soft flexible plastic e.g. squeezable bottles such as sauce bottles.	
	Hard but flexible plastic such as microwave ware, takeaway containers, some yoghurt/ice cream/jam containers, hinged lunch boxes.	
	Rigid, brittle plastic such as small tubs and margarine/butter containers.	
	All other plastics, including acrylic and nylon. Examples include some sports drink bottles, sunglasses, large water cooler bottles.	

*The number in the triangle identifies the type of plastic a container is made from, not whether or not it is recyclable. Check the list on the previous page if you are not sure.*

### Glass bottles and jars for recycling

### Other locally available recycling services

#### REDcycle

REDcycle accepts soft plastics. If it can be scrunched into a ball, it can be placed in a REDcycle drop off bin. REDcycle drop off bins are found at Coles outlets in Armidale and Tamworth.

- ✓ Cling Wrap - free of food residue
- ✓ Confectionery bags
- ✓ Dry pet food bags
- ✓ Fresh produce bags
- ✓ Frozen food bags
- ✓ Green bags (Polypropylene Bags)
- ✓ Ice cream wrappers
- ✓ Large sheets of plastic that furniture comes wrapped in (cut into A3 size pieces)
- ✓ Netting produce bags (any metal clips removed)
- ✓ Newspaper and magazine wrap
- ✓ Pasta bags
- ✓ Plastic Australia Post satchels
- ✓ Plastic carrier bags from all stores
- ✓ Plastic film wrap from grocery items such as nappies and toilet paper
- ✓ Plastic sachets
- ✓ Potting mix and compost bags (cut into A3 size pieces and free of as much product as possible)
- ✓ Rice bags
- ✓ Snap lock bags / zip lock bags
- ✓ Squeeze pouches with lid on
- ✓ Wine bladders - clear plastic ones only

Please make sure your plastic is dry and as empty as possible.

- ✗ Plastic bottles

- ✗ Any rigid plastic such as meat trays, biscuit trays or strawberry punnets
- ✗ Adhesive tape
- ✗ Blister packs, tablets and capsule packaging

- ✗ Cat and dog food pouches (these are predominantly foil)
- ✗ Coffee bags
- ✗ Cooler bags
- ✗ Disposable food handling gloves of any variety

## **Kerbside service times and Landfill Operating Hours**

### **Kerbside pick up**

The kerbside service pick up day for residents in Uralla is Wednesday.

Please place your bin outside your home on the evening before the nominated collection day so not to miss an early morning collection time. (Missed bins will not be collected until the subsequent week's service for your area.)

Please be advised that wheelie bins can not be collected if the weight exceeds 150 kg. An automatic scale on the truck rejects the bin if the weight exceeds this limit.

Residents are asked to place their bins outside their home as close to the road as practical. This should be at least 1 metre apart and with at least 1 metre clearance from any other object (e.g. a fence).
