Iris Wallis began the "Grandfriends" program over ten years ago. She noticed that many children at the local school were without grandparents because their families had recently migrated to Australia or moved around due to armed service postings or were separated from the grandparents because of divorce. She started "Grandfriends", a program where retired people adopt a class in local primary schools and spend half a day there each week, co-teaching, giving one-to-one tutoring or playing games at lunchtime.

For some children, especially those who have little contact with older people, "Grandfriends" provide an opportunity to get to know members of a different generation and to do so in a controlled environment.

Volunteer "Grandfriends" are not intended as replacement grandparents nor are they only interested in children without grandparents or those with grandparents who live far away. They are friends who help to bridge the generation gap for all young children in the community.

Iris is a much loved "Grandfriend" to so many.
