Description: This document describes Council's policy on the grazing of stock on

roads other than TSRs

To allow the Rural Lands Protection Board to issue permits for

Objective: grazing on Council roads

PART 1 - POLICY

Council gives the Rural Lands Protection Board concurrence to walk or graze stock on all public roads unless specifically removed by Council in line with the "Rural Lands Protection Act" 1998 under Section 101(3).

Public liability for stock is on issue between the RLPB and the owner/s of the stock.

Council will consider

- (a) The number and location of the stock and their impact on the safety of the road users and the environment of the road reserve.
- (b) The effect the stock may have on council works planned or occurring in the area.
- (c) Any other issues brought to Council's attention prior to removing approval for walking or grazing stock.

PART 2 - EXEMPTIONS

No stock will be allowed within 50 km/h speed limit of towns and villages except on TSRs.
