

Decommissioning Notification Underground Petroleum Storage Systems (UPSS)

Notification of decommissioning of a UPSS to the relevant local authority under section 23 of the *Protection of the Environment Operations (Underground Petroleum Storage Systems) Regulation 2019*.

The person responsible for the UPSS must notify Council of the decommissioning:

- a) at least 30 days in advance prior to the decommissioning of a UPSS, or
- b) as soon as possible in case of urgent or unforeseen decommissioning.
