Removal of timber from road sides

There are a number of very healthy and beautiful road side reserves of significant ecological and heritage importance around Uralla Shire. A number of local road sides are home to plants so rare that they are listed under State or Federal biodiversity conservation legislation. For these reasons, the removal of standing or fallen timber from road sides in the Shire is prohibited.

Council is working with local landholders, Northern Rivers CMA and Southern New England Landcare on the 'Golden Mile' project sponsored by the LGSA and Office of Environment and Heritage. This project will restore and protect native biodiversity along Linfield-Enmore Roads. Residents can do their part by leaving wood and other debris to provide habitat and nutrient within the road side.

Fire Permits

The NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) are reminding residents in the New England and Northern Tablelands areas that fire permits will be required from the start of the Bush Fire Danger Period which starts on the 1 August 2012. Any person wanting to light a fire in the open in the New England area of Armidale Dumaresq, Guyra, Uralla, Walcha and the Northern Tablelands local government areas will require a fire permit.

Permits can be obtained from local fire brigades or Fire Control Centre free of charge.
