Protecting Native Urban Bushland

Cats and weeds pose an enormous threat to the ecology of Mt Mutton, Bundarra Nature Park, Racecourse and Dangar's lagoons, Wooldridge Fossicking Area and roadside vegetation corridors around the Shire.

Cats (including the domesticated variety) take between 5 and 30 native animals a night. Simple steps to prevent your cat killing native animals include: keeping your cat in at night and attaching a bell to their collar. Neutering stops unwanted pregnancies and makes them less likely to roam and hunt. As with dogs, cat owners are required to microchip and register their pet.

Council encourages residents to replace weedy garden plants such as privet and cotoneaster with native plants, or other less invasive species. Native plants are preferable as these provide food and habitat for native animals. Removing highly invasive species in turn reduces the spread of weeds into native bushland. Further advice on weed removal is available from Councils Bush Regenerator.
