Roaming Dogs

The offence "Owner not prevent dog escaping" means that if your dog goes past your boundaries of your property, this includes the front nature strip, your dog is classified as "roaming" whether you are there or not.

Council's Ranger will collect your dog if it escapes. It is not collected just because it is an offence, or that your dog may be harmful or not, but mainly for the safety of your dog not being hurt by maybe another dog that could be out, or more importantly so your dog does not get hit by a car.
