Bundarra Boil Water Alert Update

Uralla Shire Council in conjunction with the Bundarra Store have arranged for bottled drinking water to be made available for Bundarra residents impacted by the Boil Water Alert issued on Tuesday, 7th of January 2020.

Bottled water will be available at two different locations during the following hours:

- McGregor Gourlay, 11 Bendemeer St, Bundarra
Monday, Tuesday & Wednesday from 7:30am to 4:30pm.
- Bridge Store (formerly Bottom Shop) in 30 Bendemeer St, Bundarra
Thursday, Friday & Saturday from 10am to 4pm
Sunday from 10am to 2pm

“I would like to thank the individuals and businesses including Chris Beard, Sharon Johnson and Jackie Stibbard for their involvement in distributing bottled water to the Bundarra community,” Uralla Shire Council’s Acting General Manager, Mr David Aber said. “We are working to fix the water supply problem as soon as possible”.

Any Bundarra residents unable to travel to a collection point should contact Mr Peter Gregory from the Council on 0429 691 827 to arrange for delivery of bottled water if required. Residents who have concerns for family, friends or neighbours in Bundarra who may be in this situation are asked to please contact Mr Gregory or Uralla Shire Council directly.

Bundarra residents are reminded that if they boil the town water it will make it safe to drink.

Bottled water or cool boiled water should be used for drinking, washing uncooked food (eg, salad vegetables and fruit), making ice, cleaning teeth, gargling and pet’s drinking water.
