### **April 2010 Council Resolutions**

Highlights of Council's Ordinary meeting of 19 April 2010 include the following resolutions:

- That Council be represented by Mayor R Filmer at the 2010 National General Assembly of the Australian Local Government Association from Monday, 14 June 2010 to Thursday, 17 June 2010.
- That Council note:
- ♦That submissions are being sought from the public into the Review of Implementation of the Nation Building and Jobs Plan in NSW.
- oThe Environmental Planning and Assessment Amendment (Miscellaneous) Regulation 2010 (the Miscellaneous Regulation) which came into force on 26 March 2010
- oThe consequential amendments to the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 and the Environmental Planning and Assessment Regulation 2000 regarding new arrangements for landowner's consent and notification requirements relating to applications under Part 3A and Part 4 of the Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979 when the subject land is owned by a Local Aboriginal Land Council.
- •That Council:
- Rezone land off Panhandle Road as conservation in the next Local Environmental Plan as the appropriate Environmental Protection Zone.
- Approve the following restrictions to user, giving the authority to place the Council Seal on all relevant documents: "Accept the Vegetation Rehabilitation and Management Program prepared by Armidale Tree Group Inc."

#### Resolutions cont:

- That increases of 2.6% less \$15,143 (which is effectively 2.84%) in general rate, 3.2% for Uralla Sewer, 4.7% for Uralla Water, 4.01% for Uralla Waste Collection, 4.03% for Bundarra Waste Collection, 2.98% for Rural Waste Collection, 3.28% for the Recycling Charge and 3.54% for the Environmental Levy be the basis for the Draft Revenue Policy for 2010/2011.
- That Council support the application by Mr B Wisemantel to purchase the Crown Land as marked provided Council has right of access to the Cemetery and that the fenced Cemetery area be excluded from the area to be sold.
- •That Council support the Mid North Weight of Loads draft budget of 5% increase and the review of the way the Mid North Coast Weight of Loads Group carries out its inspectoral operations.

# Kentucky Creek Drinking Water Catchment Project Starts

Council is pleased to announce funding has been received from the Border Rivers – Gwydir Catchment Management Authority for the commencement of a project to test water quality in the Kentucky catchment area. Test bores will be sunk in the Kentucky (closed) landfill site at the end of May. Creek Water testing will commence after consultation with landowners. All results and recommendations made by the hydro-geologist will be reported to Council to ensure appropriate remediation and rectification works, if required, are undertaken to keep our current and future water supply safe.
