Pine Removal on Mt Mutton

Uralla Shire Council has lodged an application to the Environmental Trust Restoration and Rehabilitation program to manage and control Pinus radiata and Pinus pinaster on Mt Mutton. The Mt Mutton area has very good quality native vegetation and is known to be used by many animals, including koalas. Funds will be used to remove pine and replace it with native vegetation. Some areas will be encouraged to revegetate naturally. Most importantly areas of native bush will be linked together to form wildlife corridors that will encourage and support a greater diversity of wildlife. - Check what you already have in your fridge, freezer and cupboard
- 3. Check what is in season before planning meals
- 4. Plan your meals around your weekly activities
- 5. Buy local produce
- 6. When planning meals include foods from the five key food groups
 - breads, cereals, rice and pasta
 - vegetables
 - fruits
 - milk, cheese and yoghurt
 - meat, fish, poultry, eggs and nuts
- 7. Get your serves right by knowing how to measure the correct amount of food for the number of people you are cooking for use the 'The Love Food Hate Waste' serving size calculator lovefoodhatewaste.nsw.gov.au/cookit/serving-size-calculator.aspx
- 8. Identify exactly how much of each ingredient you will need
- Write your shopping list from your menu planner
- Remember to take your list to the shops with your reusable shopping bags

Measuring Tips

To estimate the amount of food thrown away use the following scales. Describe the foods and amounts in a way that can be easily understood eg. ½ chocolate bar, or less than ¼ loaf of bread.

For "whole" food items, such as a fish finger, a slice of bread, a bar of chocolate, an apple, a meat joint, a leg of chicken, a cheese sandwich, a sausage or a banana, record how much is being thrown away using the scale:

- A whole 1
- Half ½
- A quarter 1/4
- Less than a quarter -- < 1/4


