Uralla Shire Council has lodged an application to the Environmental Trust Restoration and Rehabilitation program to manage and control Pinus radiata and Pinus pinaster on Mt Mutton. The Mt Mutton area has very good quality native vegetation and is known to be used by many animals, including koalas. Funds will be used to remove pine and replace it with native vegetation. Some areas will be encouraged to revegetate naturally. Most importantly areas of native bush will be linked together to form wildlife corridors that will encourage and support a greater diversity of wildlife.
