Removal of Timber from Road Sides

There are a number of very healthy and beautiful road side reserves of significant ecological and heritage importance around the Shire.

A number of road reserves are home to plants so rare they are listed under State or Federal biodiversity conservation legislation. Removing timber (standing or fallen) from the road side has a detrimental effect on the survival and health of vegetation within that roadside reserve.

For these reasons, the removal of standing or fallen timber from road sides in the Shire is prohibited.

Council is working with local landholders and Southern New England Landcare on the 'Golden Mile' project along Linfield and Enmore Roads, sponsored by the LGSA and the Office of Environment. Residents can do their part by leaving wood and other debris to provide habitat and nutrient within the road reserves.

Council will once again be conducting Clean-Up Days for the Shire in May.

The Council Clean-up Days will target green waste. Green waste will be collected along with other household items.

Please separate recyclables, such as paper, plastics and metal.

No hazardous waste, no tyres, no mattresses no televisions and no computer screens will be accepted.

Once again, this year Council will provide onsite mulching at no cost to residential properties on Clean-Up Day. Appointments for onsite mulching can be made at the Council Office.

Green waste mulching will be limited to 3 cubic metres of waste. Timber to be mulched should be no thicker than 10cm in diameter.

Other non-hazardous materials will be collected as normal.
