URALLA WATER NOTICE

Discoloured water occurs occasionally in all water supply systems. It can happen due to an interruption to power or because of a burst water main. It is not an emergency and is usually temporary. Discoloured water is not a health concern and will not damage your plumbing.

The discolouration is caused by harmless deposits of iron and manganese which occur naturally in low levels. They accumulate along the lining of the water main over time. When flow conditions change, such as when they increase due to a burst main, the physical force of the water dislodges the particles.

If you experience discoloured water run your taps until it runs clear. The water is not unsafe to drink or use, though it won't taste particularly nice. Council encourages residents to only drink clear water.

It is best to avoid doing laundry and not to do any white laundry while you have discoloured water. If you do have stained laundry keep the item wet and use an acid based cleaning agent. There are several commercial rust removers that are available in the supermarket that work quite well. Follow the instructions provided and always check for colourfastness before use.
