Uralla Story Project

A collection of audio stories which feature aspects of Uralla's local heritage has been launched by the Federal Minister for Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities, the Hon Tony Burke MP, and local member Tony Windsor MP.

Christmas Waste and Recycling

Uralla's landfill and recycling facility will be closed on Christmas Day, 25 December 2012.

From January 2013, water restrictors will be installed at properties which are in arrears of their water billing. Exemptions will be given if the owner/occupier demonstrates health reasons for non-payment or if payment arrangements have been made.
