World Wetlands Day Celebration Racecourse Lagoon Family Fun Day, Saturday 9 February 2013

To celebrate World Wetlands Day, Council are hosting a Family Fun Day at Racecourse Lagoon on Saturday, 9 February 2013. This is a free event open to all ages. The Uralla Shire is very fortunate to have a number of upland wetlands. Many wetlands have cultural and historic significance. Aboriginal people lived by Racecourse Lagoon and residents will be familiar with the horse, dog and motor boat racing that used to take place there until the mid-late twentieth century.

All wetlands play a very important role in storing and supplying clean water, grazing for stock, carbon storage and naturally are home to lots of interesting and diverse plants and animals, including a number of nationally and internationally important birds. Racecourse Lagoon has been brimming with water for a number of months and is full of interesting plants, birds and animals.

Activities on 9 February will begin at 7:00am with Bird Watching; followed by a Flora Walk at 8:00am and 9.30am; and a free BBQ breakfast at 8.30am. Family fun activities including egg and spoon races, sack and three-legged races begin at 9:00am.

Information on funding for local landholders and pest animal control will be available from Southern New England Landcare on the day. Please wear closed shoes and bring a hat, camera and binoculars.
