FREE MICROCHIPPING & DESEXING ASSISTANCE!

Applications for the Responsible Pet Ownership Grant Program are now available.

This program:

- encourages responsible pet ownership by reducing straying cats, dogs and unwanted litters
- provides free microchipping
- subsidises the cost of both cat and dog desexing by 50%

Please note that to participate in the Program your pet needs to be six months old.

Pet owners will need to pay for their pet's Lifetime Registration to Council when applying for free microchipping and subsidised cat and dog desexing.

Funding for this Program has been supplied by the Office of Local Government jointly to Uralla Shire Council and Walcha Council and is available until the end of June 2016, if not expended prior. Uralla & Walcha Veterinary Clinics have supported this program with discounted desexing fees.
