Council congratulates the Young Citizen of the Year, Kieren McGrath, who is a 22 year old Uralla man involved in the following:



URALLA LEVEL 1 WATER RESTRICTIONS

Due to dry conditions, the volume of Kentucky Creek Dam has dropped to below 74%. Uralla will commence **Level 1 water restrictions** on **Wednesday 6 February 2019**. Implications of Level 1 water restrictions for residents are that:

- Hand held hoses and drip irrigation systems should not be used between 10am & 5pm
- Sprinklers are permitted for a maximum of two (2) hours a day before 10am or after 5pm
- Cleaning hard surfaces with a hand held hose is not permitted at any time.
- Vehicle washing with buckets is permitted at any time.

Council staff will continue to monitor the situation and will update the community should condition change. Please contact Council on 6778 6300 should you have any questions or concerns.

COUNCIL'S COMMUNTY GRANTS PROGRAM NOW OPEN

Council is pleased to announce the opening of Round 2 Community Grants Program to groups and organisations for local projects meeting the guidelines. Applications will be received from 1 to 28 February 2019.

Uralla Shire Council Community Grants Program offers two types of grant category:

- 1. Groups and Organisations can apply for non-recurrent grants of up to \$3,000 (which may include in-kind support) to undertake projects/activities/events, or purchase items, which benefit the wider Uralla community. Two rounds of funding will be available each financial year Round 1 in August and Round 2 in February.
- 2. Individuals non-recurrent grants of up to \$300 are available to residents of Uralla Shire Council to pursue achievements in their chosen area of expertise; this may include, but is not limited to, significant sports and recreation, arts and culture and academic endeavours. Applications for this grant can be submitted any time of year, at least four (4) weeks prior to the planned activity.
