Wind and Solar Energy Mapping Tool: Now available until May

If you are a Uralla Shire resident, farmer or community group thinking about installing a small scale (less than 10 MW) energy generation system for non commercial purposes, you can now get access to an online mapping tool that will generate an estimate of the solar and wind resources for individual sites.

To obtain accurate data you need a map reading in latitude and longitude format for the location you propose to place the generation system. These readings can be taken from Ordinance Survey maps, some mobile phones and from the website SixLite:

Change to Ward Boundaries

Council Elections will be held on Saturday, 8 September 2012. A variation between Wards with the largest and smallest numbers of electors can not be more than 10%. The current variation between Ward A and Ward B of the Uralla Shire Council is 16.8%. Council is proposing to move 113 electors from Ward A within the Census Count District 1.05-07-06 to Ward B.
