#### Uralla Shire Community Grants Program - applications opening 1st March 2016

In July 2015, Council adopted a new Community Grants program that is available to community groups and organisations to apply for funding to undertake projects/events which benefit the wider Uralla community, depending upon availability of funds and the merit of project proposals - Non-recurrent grants of up to \$3,000 and/or in-kind support are available.

In addition Individual Grants are also available to residents of Uralla Shire to pursue achievements in their chosen area of expertise; this may include, but is not limited to significant sports and recreation, arts and culture and academic endeavours - non-recurrent grants of up to \$300.
