

NBN TO ROLLOUT IN URALLA FROM MARCH 2018

Construction of the nbn[™] broadband access network has started in Uralla. Planned availability to the nbn will progressively commence from March 2018. Some premises may require more work before they are ready to connect from the planned fibre to the node technology. Areas surrounding town and parts of the outlying areas are fixed wireless, and these areas can already order a service. Outside of the fixed wireless areas, premises are serviced by nbn[™] sky muster.

HIGH PEDESTRIAN ACTIVITY AREA CONCEPT PLAN BRIDGE STREET, URALLA

The Draft Concept Plan was presented on Tuesday evening, 27 February, at the Uralla Community Centre.

The consultant, Mr Milne Home, advised that 'closed in' intersections (to reduce the length of travel across roads for pedestrians) together with a street planting design would introduce a higher level of traffic calming & therefore pedestrian safety.

Further advice included the retention of the existing pedestrian crossing in Bridge Street with approach improvements; the relocation or removal of the Hill Street pedestrian crossing; and, the incorporation of a median refuge arrangement.
