# **Tablelands Respite for Carers of People with Dementia**

Tablelands Respite for Carers of People with Dementia is a flexible respite service for Carers of people with Dementia. Places for this service are now available.

Caring for a loved one with memory loss can be physical and emotionally exhausting, and Carers may find the behaviour of the Dementia Sufferer very challenging. Respite can provide the Carer with breaks from their caring role. Services are very flexible to meet the individual Carer's needs.

Support may be provided while the Carer takes a break, or a support person may take the 'Person under Care' for an outing in the community.

Support could include:

- Assisting with personal care and domestic tasks.
- Social support to assist the 'Person under Care' to access activities in the Community.
- Assistance for the Carer to take a short break each week, or a longer break monthly.
- Provision of over night care in the home in an emergency.

The following Items will not be accepted:

Once again, Council will provide on-site mulching on Clean-Up Day at no cost to residential properties. Appointments for on-site mulching can be made at the Council Office.

On-site mulching will be limited to a maximum of 3 cubic metres of Green Waste.

Green Waste to be mulched should be no thicker than 10cm in diameter.

Other non-hazardous materials will be collected as normal.


# **Uralla Unique Markets**
