NOTICE OF PUBLIC EXHIBITIONS

Planning Proposal for Flood Map Inclusion in Uralla Local Environmental Plan

Council is seeking public comment on the Planning Proposal to amend the Uralla Local Environmental Plan 2012. This proposal will include an additional Flood Planning Map that identifies land within a 'Flood Planning Area' derived from the Rocky and Uralla Creeks Flood Study undertaken by Paterson Consultants Pty Ltd in 2014. The planning proposal is on exhibition from Friday, 24 April 2015 to Friday, 22 May 2015 with the last day for receipt of submissions Friday, 22 May 2015.

Planning Proposal for Boundary Adjustments Clause and Detached Dual Occupancies in certain Rural Areas.

Council is also exhibiting a second Planning Proposal to include a Boundary Adjustment Clause and allow Detached Dual Occupancies in certain Rural Areas in the Uralla Local Environmental Plan 2012. This Planning Proposal is on exhibition from Friday, 24 April 2015 to Friday, 15 May 2015 with the last date for written submissions being accepted Friday, 15 May 2015.


