BUNDARRA WATER RESTRICTIONS

Due to dry conditions, the volume of Taylors Pond has dropped to 64%. Bundarra commenced Level 1 water restrictions on Monday, 16 April 2018. The implications of Level 1 water restrictions for residents are that:

- Hand held hoses and drip irrigation systems should not be used between 10 am - 5 pm.
- Sprinklers are permitted for a maximum of 2 hours a day before 10 am or after 5 pm.
- Cleaning hard surfaces with a hand held hose is not permitted at any time.
- Vehicle washing with buckets is permitted at any time.

Council staff will continue to monitor the situation and will update the community should conditions change. Please contact Council on 6778 6300 should you have any questions or concerns.

HELP KEEP URALLA CLEAN CLEAN UP AFTER YOUR DOG

Dog poo on the footpath, nature strip, or in the park, is a public health and environmental issue. It is unsightly and a smelly nuisance for other people using these public places.

How to clean up after your dog;

Suitable products are available from your local pet store, such as plastic or biodegradable bags, pouches or pooper scoopers.

If using a plastic bag, put your hand inside the bag, pick up the dog poo, turn the bag inside out and then seal. You can tie the bag to your leash or carry it until you get to a waste bin.

Dispose of via Council provided waste bins, home worm farms/ composting units (avoid putting dog poo into worm farms and composting units if they are regularly treated for parasites).

Dog owners who do not remove their dog's poo can be issued with an on-the-spot fine.
