BUNDARRA ROAD WORKS (INVERGOWRIE) ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATE

Users of Bundarra Road would be aware Council have commenced road works on Bundarra Road, 12.3km to 13.6km from Armidale. The upgrade contains an **Environmental Management Plan** (EMP) to reduce impact resulting from work activity in this bushland environment.

The EMP includes retaining vegetation from clearing activity on or near the site to ensure decomposing timber will provide habitat for native animals. Residents are asked to assist with Council's Environmental Management Plan by ensuring that this timber remains undisturbed on site.

Z-NET URALLA NEWS

Uralla has Z-Net's first "accredited" sustainable firewood business! One of our progressive firewood collectors has now completed the Z-NET training on how to assess the amount of wood that can sustainably be collected from a particular type of woodland. The inaugural training event was held at Lana in an area of box woodland. As well as a commercial firewood supplier in Uralla, a number of people who collect their own wood joined in to learn how to do a rapid assessment of how much dead wood is on the ground. This is compared to a benchmark for the woodland type, to estimate what proportion of wood can be harvested with minimal environmental impact.

Z-NET is constantly getting enquires on where sustainable firewood can be bought – the free accreditation training is a great opportunity for wood suppliers to meet this strong demand.

KEY COUNCIL ACTIONS April 2019

- Councillors attended the various Youth Week events for the young people of Uralla, including a morning tea hosted by the Mayor. Youth week events are organised by the Uralla Neighbourhood Centre and the Uralla Library (see photos on pages one and three).
- Councillors Strategic Planning Workshop to discuss: draft Strategic Business Plans for McMaugh Gardens and Tablelands Community Support/Transport; projects being funded under the Drought Community Program (which includes upgrades to community halls and other facilities within the Shire) and the Stronger Country Communities Fund includes (which multiple park improvements throughout the Shire); planning for Council managed Crown Reserves.
- Budget Review and Finance Committee to receive and discuss the first draft of the 2019-20 budget.
- Additional workshops to discuss the budget and to identify cost savings.
- Audit, Risk and Improvement Committee.
- Meeting with Barnaby Joyce MP and Senator Bridget McKenzie, the Deputy Leader of the Nationals, to view the upgrades at the Showgrounds and to discuss other related projects.
- Ordinary Council Meeting: Council resolved to: enter into a partnership with the Northern Inland Academy of Sport to support connections to coaches and sports people for the youth of Uralla; review the 2018-19 Operational Plan progress update; exhibit three policies associated with Councillor Induction and Professional Development, Work Health and Safety, Investment; note minutes of the Friends of McMaugh Gardens and **Uralla Township and Environs Committee** meetings; progress discussions with the Uralla community about opportunities for a Return and Earn to be located in Uralla; purchase a new water tanker.
