Catch up on your Council Meetings

The Ordinary Meetings

In April council resolved to:

- Place the Draft Kerb, Gutter and Footpath Paving Policy on public exhibition.
- Terminate landfilling operations at the Bundara Waste Management Facility upon reaching capacity and to hire shallow hook bins for the temporary collection to ensure continuation of service.
- Accept the offer from Campbells Fuel Services Inverell for the provision of fuel.
- Accept the offer from Valvoline for lubricant supplies.

In May Council resolved to:

- Express Council's strong opposition to the NSW Government's last minute decision to impose an enormous Emergency Services Levy, noting consequences of the unannounced 73% increase significantly erode the 3.7% increase that was to provide essential community services and infrastructure.
- Further progress the Draft Tree Management Policy for Council- Managed Land 2023.
- Uralla Shire Schools will be exempt from fees and charges for the use of Uralla Sporting Complex.
- Award contract to Stabilcorp for \$223,300.00 (GST incl) to provide pavement stabilisation for the Gostwyck Road Project
