PUBLIC HEARING

Uralla Shire Council Land Reclassification

Council is proposing to reclassify land from 'community' to 'operational' as part of a Planning Proposal to amend the Uralla Local Environmental Plan 2012. The land is identified as:

- Gravel Pit, Bingara Rd Bundarra, Lot 1 DP 1062924
- Bundarra West Reservoir, Muirhead St, Bundarra, Lot 1 DP 1165352
- Caravan Park, Queen St Uralla, Lot 30 DP 793510
- Water Race, Kliendienst Rd Uralla, Lot 613 DP 755846

A Public Hearing in respect of these proposed reclassifications is required to be held in accordance with Section 57(6) of the *Environmental Planning & Assessment Act 1979* and Section 29(1) of the *Local Government Act 1993*. The Public Hearing will be chaired by a suitably qualified planning professional independent of Council.

The Public Hearing is to be held at Uralla Shire Council Chambers, 32 Salisbury Street, Uralla on Wednesday, 16 October 2013 commencing at 10:00 am. If you wish to make a submission at the public hearing, please advise Council by 4:00pm Monday, 14 October 2013.

Local sporting groups may apply for NSW Government grants which could fund new sport facilities or programs to help people get active. Applications for Round One of the Sport and Recreation Participation and Facility Program 2013-14 close on 30 October 2013.

Key points of the program are:

- Grants are capped at \$10,000 for participation projects and \$25,000 for facility projects;
- Organisations may apply for multiple projects or project types, with the maximum available to any one organisation in a financial year capped at \$50,000; and
- Applicants must contribute 50% or more to the project.


