Future Direction of U3CF Forum

The future direction of U3CF is to be the focus of a public forum to be held at the Uralla Council Chambers on Thursday 30 October 2014 commencing at 5.30pm.

In October 2008, a Group of 18 local residents provided the Uralla Shire Council with 40 recommendations in respect to mitigation and adaption for climate change.

These recommendation were adopted by Council at its meeting of Monday 15 December 2008.

The U3CF Group followed on from the Uralla Climate Consensus Forum in 2009 to provide an advocacy and discursive role in promoting and analysing environmental issues and their solutions. Suggestions from U3CF were taken to the Uralla Shire Council's Environmental Committee for deliberation and any recommendation was taken to the Full Council meeting for action.

Over the past five years the original 40 recommendations have been either actioned, advocated or determined as not actionable by Council. The completion of the task combined with a change in the Council's Committee Structure is an opportunity to redefine the role and focus of the U3CF Group. One of the suggestions is for a name change to define the changed role.

If you are interested in having a Group with the ability to provide suggestions and solutions to our local council come along on the last Thursday of this month and have an input.

REGULATORY NEWSLETTER

September 2014

Bush Fire Protection

Now is the time to undertake maintenance around your property and home in preparation for the bush fire season. Most people associate bush fire threats with close proximity to dense vegetation (e.g. National Parks, State Forest, Reserves, etc.). Whilst these areas pose a significant threat, a bush fire can also be sustained within grass paddocks and can spread long distances via wind blown embers. This means a large number of properties within the Uralia Shire are at risk from a bush fire attack. To prepare for the bush fire season, it is recommended that property owners:

- Maintain asset protection zones;
- Ensure that a water supply dedicated to fire fighting is available;
- Maintain any fire trails; and
- Mend any holes in the sub-floor, window or gutter guards.

The NSW Rural Fire Service provides useful information in relation to bush fire protection. Attached to this bulletin is the Fact Sheet—Bush Fire and Your Home, which outlines maintenance activities to be undertaken around your house and garden. Please remember—not all homes can be protected. Your safety is always the first priority. Additional information in relation to bush fire protection can be found at www.rfs.nsw.gov.au

Temporary Swimming Pools

As we approach the warmer months, the use of swimming pools will start to increase. Accordingly, residents are reminded that any pool that is capable of being filled with water to a depth of 300 millimetres (30cm) or more requires a pool fence (childresistant barrier). This includes inflatable, demountable or

portable swimming pools. Depending on the size, capacity and the location of any temporary swimming pool, you may also require development consent from Council.

Many of these pools can be purchased over the counter at various retailers. It is always best to contact Council to check the



requirements before making your purchase. For further information in relation to swimming pool safety and regulations, Council's Technical Services Department can be contacted on 6778 6300.

Application Tracking

Uralla Shire has recently implemented two new exciting systems that will allow improved access to property development information that are fast, standardised, paperless and available anywhere, anytime. Both the EHC and Application Tracking can be found on the Council web page at www.uralla.nsw.gov.au and are ready to explore whenever you wish.

The Electronic Housing Code (EHC)

The EHC is an easy to use online system that allows owners to investigate what work they can carry out on their own property without any planning approvals (Exempt Development), or using a fast-tracked approval process (Complying Development). Property owners can make important decisions about their property with confidence.

Benefits of the EHC system include:

- Faster, easier planning approvals online no need to visit Council during business hours to lodge an application or receive advice.
- Free to use accessed via a web browser, so no software is required.
- Provides greater investment certainty helps to identify any relevant land based development restrictions much earlier.

Overgrown Land & Vermin

Uralla Shire residents take pride in the appearance of our community. Along with the warmer weather come the inevitable long grass, snakes and vermin. Over the next 6 - 8 months long grass and rubbish are a habitat in which these animals hide. Council wish to remind our residents that minimising the potential habitats on their land will help prevent the harbourage of those unwanted pests.

Application Tracking Online

Once your application is underway Application Tracking will allow you to track your development applications online, or those in an area of interest. You can search Application Tracking using a variety of categories, including street address, legal description, date range, application number or development description.

Incinerating or Burning Off

It's a fantastic time of year throughout the New England and the Shire is looking great despite the lack of rain. The sun is out, weather is warming up and the yard maintenance has started. We are encouraged by the amount of residences getting an early start on their yard clearance of long grass and potential habitats for those unwanted vermin. Please be reminded that it is illegal to burn off or incinerate in the Town and Villages unless you have a specific exemption. The NSW Rural Fire Service must be contacted for rural burning permits.


