## MAYORAL MESSAGE

Uralla has a great heritage in its history, its buildings, its landscape and undoubtedly in its residents past and present. A glimpse of the history of a town or district is often obtained by a walk through the local cemetery and many of Australia's former goldfield towns have only a cemetery remaining to tell a tale of the past existence. Uralla is fortunate to have a golden past (Rocky River goldfield) and a cemetery in which so many gravestones, carrying snippets of history, remain.

Burials were performed at the old cemetery from as early as 1823 until its official closure in 1966. The cemetery was officially dedicated on 9 March 1894 even though there had been internments at the site for many years previously. It follows that much of the early history of our town is contained within this precinct. The Old Cemetery, Uralla Square, John Street is item #90 in the List of Heritage Items on Page 39 of The Uralla Shire Council Local Environment Plan 1988, which arose from the Uralla Heritage Study of 1987.

The National Trust of Australia (NSW) in its e-mail Newsletter of January 2010 reported:

*"As part of its campaign to encourage local councils to undertake heritage studies and have comprehensive heritage lists on their Local Environmental Plans, the Trust has gained considerable media exposure in regional New South Wales on this issue. Some councils are failing to list items of heritage significance on their Local Environment Plans, an opportunity which the National Trust says could help boost tourism to rural areas. However, the Trust is aware of a number of councils who are failing to meet the requirements of listing heritage items on their Local Environment Plans (LEPs), set out by Department of Planning directives. The Trust is concerned that some councils are neglecting to investigate and list some of the most important heritage items in the State. Not only does it this put these places under threat of demolition for redevelopment, it also directly affects their tourism attraction and the local economy."*

It is therefore with great pride and pleasure that the Uralla Shire Council has produced this "Old Uralla Cemetery" booklet. The Booklet is not only a list of graves and a map of the gravesites but also contains information about styles of headstones, epitaphs, a short history of the cemetery, extracts from obituaries of number of Uralla pioneers and listing of the inscription on remaining and former headstones – now lost. No history of Uralla can be completed without some reference to "Thunderbolt" and the life of Fred Ward and the death of "Captain Thunderbolt".

Whether you are a descendant of a pioneer Uralla family, student of history, present resident of Uralla, visitor, potential visitor or casual observer, the Uralla Shire Council is sure that you will find this booklet enjoyable, enlightening and something to treasure as we treasure our pioneers and their heritage.

# HISTORY

The prelude to the official formation of the township of Uralla was the founding of the Rocky River Gold Field, over which there is a degree of controversy. What is generally accepted is that on the 7<sup>th</sup> October, 1887, Commissioner Massie reported the discovery of gold at Rocky River. Uralla's birth can be attributed solely to gold mining.

McCrossin's Mill was constructed in the late 1860's and early 1870's by John McCrossin. At the time, there were also two other steam-powered flour mills operating in Uralla, one operated by a man named Kirkwood and the other by a man named Porter. It has been stated that until the early 19<sup>th</sup> century, the Northern Tablelands was exclusively the domain of Anaiwan Aboriginal communities. By the end of the century, the 600 Aboriginals estimated to have been living on the Tablelands at the time of White settlement had been reduced to around 300.

The Robertson Lands Act of 1861 encouraged more highly-concentrated residences. Initial settlements in the region consisted of predominantly sparse sheep/cattle stations.

Uralla was declared a town on 4 October 1890 and the cemetery was dedicated on 9 March 1894. In July 1910, trustees determined to close the cemetery to any new burials other than within the present enclosures. Fortunately, the cemetery escaped becoming a Pioneer Park in the 1960s with the removal of headstones to the fence-line and the planting of lawn grass. The removal of the headstones in other parks had led to the disturbance of family relationships. In 1966, Uralla Council determined that no further burials were to take place within the cemetery and today some 185 headstones or gravesites are still visible.

It is interesting to note the axis of the cemetery in relationship to the plan of Uralla. The sides of the cemetery are in line with cardinal points but the survey of the town broke the continuity of John and Uralla Streets. The cemetery was shown as Uralla Square in early town maps. Today it is referred as the Old Uralla Cemetery to distinguish from the Uralla Cemetery now used for burials.

Small streets ran at right angles to join the tree-lined highway to Armidale. The New England Highway was originally known as the Great Northern Road and it followed Queen Street.

# HEADSTONE STYLISATION

There is a close relationship between the design of gravestones and the architectural style of the time. Early headstones are simple with little decoration and this can be seen in the Norman upright shape and the anthropomorphic design, where there is a representation of the head and shoulders of a human figure. Obelisks and columns are seen in this cemetery with one broken to symbolize a shortened life. A number of Greek cinerary urns sometimes shrouded or garlanded are evident demonstrating classical features of style. Above all, the skills of the stonemason are evident as they carved the stone to suit the taste of the grieving families.

In time, more decorations were used as demonstrated by the Victorian buildings constructed in the late 1800s. The Victorian love of symbolism is evident in the cemetery as stonemasons used a number of ancient symbols on their headstones. The symbols observed in this cemetery include: a **skull** representing mortality; the **poppy** representing sleep; the **palm leaf** representing a spiritual victory with the martyr's triumph over death; the **lamb** representing childhood innocence; **shaking hands** representing farewell or welcome to everlasting life; **ivy** representing a symbol of hope by an everlasting plant and the **crown** representing the crown of glory mentioned by Saint Paul in 1 Corinthians 9:25. The **descending dove** is the traditional symbol of the Holy Spirit and the **dove with an olive sprig** alluded to Noah's dove and a symbol of promise and hope. The **lily** is a symbol of virginity and purity while grief and loss is symbolized by **weeping willows** and **sad-faced allegorical figures**. The **book** represents knowledge or the Book of Life - the Bible, which can be open or closed. The **shell** is an ancient design but is also representative of fertility and the resurrection while the **olive branch** represents peace. A number of crosses appear: the decorated **Celtic Cross**; **Christ the King on the Crucifix**; the **Calvary Cross** with the three steps representing faith, hope and charity and the simple **Latin Cross**. The **thistle** represents earthly sorrow and sin but it can also represent the early Scottish settlers in New England. Other places of origin are represented by the **rose** for the English and the **shamrock** for the Irish. A person's **trade** or **profession** is demonstrated by the Masonic symbols of the setsquare and compass. Some of these images are shown in the photographs below

## EPITAPHS

The headstone and epitaph can reveal details of birth and death, age, cause of death, family relationships, religious beliefs and a personal assessment of the deceased family member.

Thomas Cahill (no.57) was a native of Rock of Cashill, county of Tipperary, Ireland whilst John Cameron (no.147) was a native of Ardhamchan, Argyleshire, Scotland. John was killed by a fall from his horse. George Stanley Borland (no.11) was aged 8 months and 10 days and his verse indicates the family's attitude to death:

*'Another little lamb has gone  
To dwell with him who gave  
Another little darling babe,  
Is sheltered in the grave.'*

The same verse appears on the headstone for Herbert Eric Rice (no.87), who died on 16 October 1889, aged 6 years.

The inevitability of death is shown on George Murray's headstone (no.106), who died aged 35 years on 18 June 1896:

*'The cup was bitter, the loss severe,  
To part with him we loved so dear  
It was God's will it should be so  
By his command we all must go.'*

Childbirth could be very dangerous to females. Lena Nay (no.55), died on 10 May 1917 aged 29 years and she lost her son Kevin, aged 5 weeks on 9 April 1917. Erected by her husband, the headstone records:

*'May their souls rest in peace.'*

Much personal tragedy is recorded on headstone no. 15, for the Frost family. It records the death of a number of children: Geoffrey aged 8 years, Leo James aged 2 weeks, Ronald Bruce aged 7 months, Rebecca aged 3 years and Florence aged 6 years. The verse states:

*'Sleep sleep holy babes upon thy saviour's breast  
How sweet it is to see them lie in such a place of rest.'*

Some residents suffered quietly from illness. Florence Blanch, (no.112) died aged 33 years on 20 May 1901. The verse states:

*'Through all pains at times she'd smile  
A smile of heavenly birth  
And when the angels called her home  
She smiled her farewell to earth.'*

Not all residents are buried in the cemetery. A headstone records the death of Corporal Thomas Polson (no. 65) who was killed in action at Villers Brettoneux in France on 3 April 1918, aged 31 years. During World War One, deceased soldiers were not returned home.



## OBELISK

The burial site of an early pioneer, John McCrossin; who died on November 1881, has an obelisk set in the centre of the cemetery. Erected by the Uralla community in 1882, the obelisk commemorates the role played by John McCrossin in the expedition led by Captain John Mackay and the establishment of Port Mackay in northern Queensland and his pioneering within the Uralla community. The obelisk reads:

*'Residing in this district 40 years a  
pioneer of Uralla and for many  
years the leading merchant there*

*In 1858 in conjunction with Captain  
John Mackay and party he explored  
a large portion of northern Queensland and  
discovered Port Mackay*

*A sincere and faithful friend ever  
willing to extend a helping hand  
to the deserving*

*He commands the respect and the  
esteem of the community.*

*This monument was erected  
by personal friends*

*Erected AD 1882'*

It was John McCrossin who first established a shop and milling business in Uralla. The old mill now accommodates McCrossins Museum, a significant museum telling the story of the Chinese role in mining, the Thunderbolt legend and other aspects of Uralla's local history.

Part of the granite tablet from the obelisk can be seen at the museum.



## WEATHERING

The headstones hold scientific value because of the growth of lichen and mosses. The main local material used for headstones was granite, however only eight of these headstones have survived; they are weathered, badly eroded and difficult to read because the original engraving was too shallow. The metal headstones in the cemetery were produced by the local Phoenix foundry which is the oldest operating foundry in Australia and the building and contents are of national significance incorporating original machinery, black sand casting floor, blacksmiths shop and five thousand cedar pattern pieces. Unfortunately the metal has also weathered and some of the wording is very difficult to read.

## LANDSCAPING

Early photographs indicate that there were plantings on the graves such as roses and flowers but these have been lost over time.



Today, modern cemeteries plant native species.

In this cemetery trees were planted along the fence-line. In early days, pine trees were popular in cemeteries because they are evergreen. It is planned to replant vegetation to offer protection from the wind and to also construct a reproduction picket fence.



# CAPTAIN THUNDERBOLT

On the eastern side of the cemetery, is the burial site of the bushranger Frederick Ward 'Thunderbolt' who died on 25 May 1870. In the early days, a simple wooden cross marked the burial site and a picket fence set the grave apart from the other burials. Various community efforts have been made to improve the grave but the work often attracted much community criticism. It was the efforts of Mr. A L Crapp of Uralla that placed a headstone on his grave in August 1914. He felt that it was important 'to record a historical fact and further to mark the bushranger's burial place in a manner that would convince visitors to the old cemetery, many of whom are attracted by the fact of Thunderbolt's remains reposing there.'



In March 1937 the Uralla mayor suggested that Thunderbolt's grave be bricked in with the headstone set in. A part of the move to promote tourism and Thunderbolt, a 'Thunderbolt Centenary' was held in Uralla from 15-24 May 1970.

Captain Thunderbolt undoubtedly left behind a considerable legacy in Uralla and other surrounding localities. Uralla promotes itself as being 'Thunderbolt Country' and a large statue of Thunderbolt on a horse stands in the town's main street. Thunderbolt has become an important part of the town's history, as he can be linked to the pioneer heritage of the town. Businesses in the area also bear his name, so in fact Thunderbolt is a key component of local business.

A number of other towns in the region proclaim their ties to Thunderbolt, or to events related to Thunderbolt. For example, a man by the name of James Earl ran the Squatters Arms hotel in Collarenebri and in 1866, Thunderbolt is said to have stolen money from there, as well as a few other local businesses. Today, there is a street bearing the name 'James Earl' in Collarenebri, due to his entangle-

ment with the bushranger. Other towns which witnessed the presence of Thunderbolt include Maitland, Quirindi and Carroll, near Gunnedah.

Thunderbolt forms a significant part of the much-celebrated bushranger heritage of New South Wales and Victoria.



# 'The gentleman bushranger'

Fred Ward was born at Wilberforce, near Windsor, New South Wales. Most historians state that Ward was born in either 1835 or 1836 – there is no certainty regarding this detail, given that there is no documented record of his birth. Ward was the son of Michael Ward, a convict.

Thunderbolt's father, Michael Ward, was a convict transported in 1814. He was convicted of stealing liquor and originally sentenced to death in Middlesex, UK. However, this sentence was commuted to seven years in the penal colony of Australia. Michael's wife, Sophia, sailed into New South Wales as a free settler to rejoin him two months later. This was a brave move on the part of Sophia. Conveniently, Michael was assigned to a working party on the farm where Sophia was living. The family grew,

with Sarah, Emily, Joshua, George, Hester and Selina all arriving before Fred.

Fred Ward quickly developed horse-handling skills throughout his youth, skills which he would later use to great effect to evade police for several years. He was a regular at horse racing events throughout the Northern Tablelands and Liverpool Plains regions of New South Wales. Ward frequently sought out race horses, as they possessed the speed and stamina he would need to evade the authorities.



Mary-Ann Bugg, whom would become Fred Ward's wife, had actually married a shepherd by the name of Edmund Baker, when she was still only 14 years of age. After marrying Baker, Bugg had moved to Mudgee and was later employed by Ward's sister at the property known as Cooyal Station – this is where she would have met Thunderbolt. Being of a similar age, an attachment formed between Bugg and Fred Ward

In 1856, Ward was sentenced to the notorious Cockatoo Island prison in Sydney Harbour for the crime of receiving stolen horses. He was sentenced to ten years but served only four after being released on Tickets of Leave. After being released, he returned to Cooyal Station in July 1860.

It appears that while Fred Ward was in prison, Edmund Baker had died.

Later, Mary-Ann moved to Stroud and obtained employment in the local Anglican boarding school. Ward followed her to Stroud and he gained employment on a property in the area.

Ward and Bugg were married in the Church of England church in Stroud by late 1860. The children of the associated school were given time off to watch the wedding, although to this day no marriage certificate has been located.



Further hardship for Ward followed in 1861, when he was late for a muster at the Mudgee Police Station and arrested. He was ordered to return to Cockatoo Island to serve out the remainder of his original sentence. Two weeks after Ward's sentencing, Mary-Ann gave birth to their first child, a daughter named Marina Emily Ward. Being noted as a dedicated family man, the timing of this imprisonment would have been a particularly bitter blow.

While the following few months remain something of a mystery, what is known is that Bugg soon relocated to Balmain, where she gained employment as a housemaid under the name of Louisa Mason. This post allowed her to frequently swim across the shark-infested waters of the harbour to the prison, taking with her a file which could be used to break out of the prison chains. This task was made all the more difficult with the jailers throwing offal into the water to encourage the presence of sharks.

On September 11, 1863, Fred Ward and his fellow prisoner, Fred Britten, escaped from Cockatoo Island prison by swimming to Balmain. It is believed that Mary-Ann Bugg

assisted in this escape, swimming with them and helping protect them from the sharks, further emphasising her bravery and loyalty. Nobody had ever escaped from Cockatoo Island before.

After being hidden in Balmain by Bugg for a number of days, Ward and Britten were involved in a number of hold-ups in the New England, culminating in an attempted hold-up of a coach just south of Uralla, in which Ward was shot in the leg. After this event, Britten and Ward parted ways, with Britten going to Victoria.

Following the departure of Fred Britten, Ward robbed the tollbar at Campbell's Hill, near Maitland, where he proceeded to pound on the wall of the office and demand that the personnel there surrender the toll money. The story goes that as he was about to knock on the wall there was a very loud clap of thunder and a bolt of lightning. Upon knocking, when asked his name, Ward replied 'Thunderbolt', thus the name was born.

Reported crimes committed by Captain Thunderbolt and his gang notably with no deaths;

- 25 mail coach robberies
- 16 hotels and stores
- 16 stations and residence
- 6 hawkers
- 1 tollbar gate
- 80 thefts of horses
- 1 escape of lawful custody

Police were alerted to Thunderbolt's presence outside Uralla by an Italian, Giovanni Cappisotti, who had just been held up by Ward. Captain Thunderbolt was shot by Constable Walker, a Uralla policeman, on 25 May, 1870, just outside Uralla.



The following is an extract from the statement made by Constable Walker;

*'...he immediately plunged his horse into the water and his horse stumbled and went underneath the water when Ward made a rush at the constable into the water with his revolver in his hand. The Constable fired and Ward fell forward into the water and went under and when he came up he turned to catch hold of the Constable, who then struck him on the top of the head with the revolver...he (the Constable) drew Ward out of the creek and believed him to be quite dead...'*

Leading Thunderbolt historians are contrasting in their views on the resting place of Captain Thunderbolt, as can be seen by the following;

**LINDSAY FRAZER:** *'I do believe it was truly Fred Ward who was buried there (Uralla).'*

Why?

Thunderbolt's body was identified by locals after he was shot and the reportedly said, 'Oh, yeah, that's poor old Fred over there.'

**BARRY SINCLAIR:** *'My family disagrees with the fact that it's Fred Ward (buried at Uralla).'*

Why?

Ward's brother, William, came up to Uralla about 12 months before Thunderbolt died >> He was buried and took on the part of Thunderbolt. Sinclair's family tells a story which says that Thunderbolt was seen at the funeral of his brother in Uralla.

**ARNOLD GOODE:** *'The official report was that Senior Sergeant Ball, who was at Cockatoo Island some years before, had known Thunderbolt when he was in prison. And he identified this body as Fred Ward, alias Thunderbolt.'*

Whilst these leading figures put forward their own sources of evidence, the truth may never be known. What do you think?

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# GRAVE TALES

Cemeteries are filled with people from all walks of life and are a remembrance of a whole community. The Old Uralla Cemetery is no different with some family members of this Uralla Pioneer group being buried in the Old Uralla Cemetery.

The stories contained within cemeteries are vast and interesting. There are far too many to be contained in this publication, but Council's Heritage Advisor, Mr Graham Wilson has prepared the following biographies as a select list of residents buried in the Old Uralla Cemetery. The information has been obtained from various editions of the *Uralla Times*. For various reasons, not all residents particularly females had published obituaries. More detailed on burials and lives may be available at the Heritage Centre, University of New England Archives, Armidale or the Family Group, Kentucky Street, Armidale.

## **George Barnden**

Aged 92 years, George Barnden senior died from 'senile decay' on 24 August 1907 as reported in the *Uralla Times*, 28 August 1907. He came to 'Balala Station' with the property owners Morse and Tearle, some sixty-three years earlier. He saw the rise and fall of Rocky River goldfields and the establishment of Uralla. For the last few years of his life, he lived with his son George at Uralla. He was interred in the cemetery alongside his wife, who had predeceased him some twenty-three years earlier.



## **Jonathan Bullen**

The *Uralla Times*, Wednesday 12 April 1892 reported that 'another old and well known resident of the Uralla district died on the morning of Wednesday last, having reached three score and ten years. The remains were buried in the Uralla cemetery on Friday last, the funeral procession being a rather large one.'

## **Charles Cooper**

A well known and respected resident, Charles Cooper died on Tuesday 1 October 1885. The *Uralla Times*, 9 December 1885 published a detailed report on his life. He had resided in the district for thirty-five years and for many years 'conducted a considerable business as a general storekeeper in Uralla' in partnership with John T. Crapp. Initially it was claimed that death 'was due to other than natural causes' but the police determined that 'death was the result of chronic disease of the vital organs.' A native of London, he left a wife, eight sons and two daughters.

## **Sarah Cruickshank**

The *Uralla Times*, Wednesday 27 April 1910 reported that 'another old identity of this district passed "The Great Divide" on Saturday last, in the person of Mrs Sarah B. Cruickshank, relict of the late Mr Robert Cruickshank, of Salisbury Plains.' Aged 82 years, 'she was held in high esteem by a large number of friends for her kindly disposition.'

## **William Davidson**

William Davidson, born in County Sterling Scotland, died aged 76 years on 15 May 1878. The *Uralla Times*, 1 June 1878 reported: 'A resident of the district, father of Mr D. Davidson ... passed over to the majority on Saturday last.' A number of other members of the Davidson family are buried in the cemetery. In time, the Davidson family became a long established name throughout New England.

## **Henry Elbe**

Henry Sheldon Elbe, an infant of fourteen days and the grandson of Uralla Alderman Henry Sheldon Goddard, died at his residence on 28 January 1886. The *Uralla Times*, 3 February 1886 described the moving scene at the cemetery: 'the tiny coffin containing the remains being brought to the grave by four young girls dressed in costumes emblematic of innocence.'

## **H.S. Goddard**

After a long illness extending over six months, Mr H.S. Goddard 'crossed the great divide' at his Salisbury Street residence in the presence of his wife, two daughters, grandchildren and some friends on Saturday 10 February 1900. Amongst those who were kind and attentive were members of Court New England, Order of Oddfellows, as Mr Goddard 'was regarded as the father of Forestry in New England.' He was descended from Devonshire ancestry and came from Stratton in that country.

With his wife he emigrated to South Australia some thirty-five years ago, moved to Sydney and then came to Tamworth to take part in the construction of Lewis' flour mill. He arrived in Uralla to supervise the installation of the machinery in McCrossin's Mill and with a partner, he established the New England Foundry in 1872.

The *Uralla Times*, 14 February 1900 described further aspects of his life as well as describing the funeral in detail. The first part of the service was conducted at St Johns Church and at the Old Cemetery, the concluding prayers were read by the officiating clergy as well as the Forester's ritual by Brother Naacke. Pall bearers were members of the several courts of the district including Walcha, Hillgrove Metz and Armidale.



## John O'Connor

A brewer Mr O'Connor aged 70 years, born in Dublin in 1810, died at his Uralla residence. He landed in Australia in 1830 and spent the first few years in Sydney. As a young man he travelled to the Macleay River and then onto the Hunter River at Morpeth where he remained for seventeen years in the employ of Captain Rapsey as a wharfinger. From there he took a whaling voyage through the Southern seas and on his return to Sydney met his brother of Bundarra. He gave up the sea and settled with him at Moreton Bay but he arrived at the Rocky River with the first gold rush. For thirty-five years he lived there and left a widow, three sons, three daughters, seventeen grandchildren, a brother and a sister in England. A large number of friends attended his funeral and as the *Uralla Times*, 27 April 1887 states: 'The cause of his death was a general break-up of the constitution.'

Some eighteen months later, the *Uralla Times*, 19 September 1888 described the 'high class standard of the monumental work executed at the yard of Mr W. Ambrey, Uralla.' Apart from other district headstones, one neat stone was 'to the memory of the late Mr John O'Connor.'

## John McCrossin

Following ten weeks suffering 'from a most painful illness', John McCrossin of the Union Store, died in the presence of his wife and a few relatives on Friday 30 March 1888 at his Uralla residence. The *Uralla Times*, 4 April 1888 reveals much of his life. He left a widow and young daughter and was a member of the Uralla Masonic Lodge of Peace. Members of the Lodge 'held a lodge of sorrow at their rooms on Saturday before the funeral.' Many town and country residents attended including local Masonic members and members of the Armidale Lodge dressed in full regalia. The newspaper believed that it was the first full Masonic funeral held in Uralla.

## David McNeil

A well known produce merchant and general storekeeper died at his Armidale Street residence on Wednesday 3 February 1886. In his business he amassed considerable wealth as revealed by the *Uralla Times*, 10 February 1886. He came from Scotland some thirty-five years ago. Once the railway arrived he located his produce business near the railway goods shed. At one stage, he was a major agent for the extensive carrying and forwarding agency business of Wright, Heaton and Co. Following Scottish custom, a religious service was carried out at his home before travelling to the cemetery. Numerous Uralla and district residents marched in the procession and as it passed St John's Church 'the bell was tolled as a mark of respect to the memory of the deceased.'

## Alexander McMillan

Alexander McMillan was born on the Isle of Skye, Scotland and came to Australia with his parents at the age of four years. He died on 19 August 1907 and the *Uralla Times*, 24 August 1907 published a detailed biography. In 1862 the family came to New England where he and his brother worked the first threshing machine in the district. He married and settled on the land. He left a family of nineteen children and thirty-eight grandchildren.



## Alexander McPhee

Many country cemeteries contain the remains of people without headstones. Tragically, Alexander McPhee died suddenly at the Uralla lock-up. The *Uralla Times*, 14 March 1888 states that despite care from Senior-constable Condran and Constable Perkins, 'the unfortunate fellow's ailment was apparently too much for human skill, and he died, a stranger in a strange place, on Saturday last. The remains were interred at the expense of the Government on Sunday morning.'

## Tom Polson

Many Australian country towns lost young men during World War One. They were buried in cemeteries close to the battle scene and sometimes family members established headstones in the town to commemorate their loss. The *Uralla Times*, 20 April 1918 states that two Uralla men died in France on 5 April 1918: Corporal Harold Betts and Corporal Tom Polson. The newspaper continued 'two or more of our young men must be added to the growing list of those gallants who had had their "hour of glory" and died in defence of their country and to its people.' The flag at the Council Chambers was hung at half-mast and the Mayor presented a sympathetic speech. Later the Polson family erected the headstone as a memorial to their son.

## William Ryan

Numerous members of the Ryan family are buried in the cemetery. The *Uralla Times*, Saturday 22 August 1914 reported that an old and respected person, William Ryan 'had passed across the Great Divide on Monday last, at the ripe old age of 80 years.' At the time of his death he was visiting his daughter at Salisbury Plains. A native of Ballingarry, Ireland he had been living in the district for over forty years. Soon after his arrival, he selected a property 'Rose Hill' which his son John now managed. His wife pre-deceased him by nine years and he left two sons and four daughters.

## Charles Smith

Aged 98 years, he died on 20 November and the *Uralla Times*, 23 November 1922 published a detailed biography. He was born at Agden Green, Huntingdonshire, England on 3 May 1824. On 31 August 1849 he set sail with his wife and two children and arrived in Morpeth three days after Christmas. The family travelled to Piedmont Station, Barraba where they stayed for 12 months, thence 'Salisbury Station' and 'Boorolong Station' where he worked for five or six years. For several years he worked at 'Salisbury' and in 1862 he selected 'Agden Green' where he resided until the property was sold in 1921. Thirty-two years earlier his wife died as did their daughter, Mrs James Manuel at the same time 'from la grippe, or flu as it is known today.' Apart from his four sons and two daughters, he left eighty grandchildren and about thirty great grandchildren.



## **Elizabeth Vickers**

The tragedy of childbirth caused Elizabeth Vicker's death, the only daughter of Samuel McCrossin and the wife of Richard Vickers, on Friday 1 July 1881. In the words of the *Uralla Times*, 6 July 1881, 'the immediate cause of death was exhaustion after childbirth.' Her death was 'rendered more sad by the fact that deceased was at the time of her death in the heyday of life, and had usually the best of health.' She was only twenty-eight years old. Her infant son Ronald died on 28 December 1881 aged six months, and was buried alongside his mother.

## **Audley Vincent**

Little was published in the local paper to announce the death of a child. However, when the editor of the local newspaper lost his child, the *Uralla Times*, 5 October 1881 reported: 'On Thursday, September 29, at 6 pm, after a short illness from inflammation of the lungs, Audley Edward Frank, eldest child of Frank Walter and Sarah Vincent, aged 10 years, 2 months and 13 days. 'I heard a voice from heaven, saying unto me, Write, from henceforth blessed are the dead which lie in the Lord; ever so saith the Spirit, for they rest from their labours.' There are no other members of the Vincent family buried in the cemetery.

## **George Western**

The *Uralla Times*, Wednesday 17 March 1886 reported the death of a remarkable Uralla resident when Mr George Western 'passed over to the silent majority on Sunday afternoon last.' For some months he had laid gravely ill at his Maitland Point residence. He passed away in the presence of Alderman John Bliss, Mr D. Pearson and other close friends. A native of Surrey, England, he had arrived in NSW about 1841 or 1842. Initially he travelled to the north-west but later entered the services of the late Mr A. Dangar at 'Gostwyck Station'. He became manager of the store on the property and later became a storekeeper on the Rocky River goldfields. A generous man, he had donated £1000 to both St John's Anglican Church in Uralla and the Armidale hospital.


## **William Wilkinson**

Aged 68 years and unmarried, William Wilkinson died at St Elmo Hospital from heart trouble early in May 1936. He had been a trusted employee of the Vickers family of 'Goldsworth Station' for forty years. He was survived by a brother Richard who had also worked at the station for some forty years before retiring to Sydney. The burial took place in the family plot and was attended by a number of relatives and friends. (*Uralla Times*, 7 May 1936).



# MAP

The numbers refer to an earlier recording of headstones. They refer to the position of the headstone in relationship to the northern boundary fence adjacent to the Uralla Central School; that is, headstone No. 1 indicating the burial site of Sam and Ann BUSSELL, is located close to the northern boundary fence.
